- DESCRIPTION:** Participants will demonstrate an understanding of the Pokémon franchise. (For any clarifications/questions, competitors should reach out to jpan346@gatech.edu.)
A TEAM OF UP TO: 2 **APPROXIMATE TIME:** 50 minutes **CALCULATOR:** Class II
- EVENT PARAMETERS:**
 - Each team must bring writing utensils.
 - Each team may bring up to two class I or class II calculators.
 - No resources **or other tools**, except those provided by the Event Supervisor, may be used.
- THE COMPETITION:**
 - The event will test competitors' knowledge and understanding on the following topics:
 - Pokémon identification:** Identify based on appearance, identify its type(s), abilities, evolutions, etc.
 - Official Pokémon Games:**
 - Mainline series: Release dates, storyline, locations, prominent NPCs (gym leaders, evil team admins, etc.)
 - Spin-offs: Storyline, gameplay,
 - Pokémon puzzles:** puzzles found in the games (strength puzzles, ice puzzles), puzzles themed around Pokémon (Pokédoku, Pokédle, etc.)
 - Pokémon TCG:** TCG Expansion Sets, popular chase cards, card effects (foil, holographic), game knowledge, etc.
 - Pokémon Battles:** Battle mechanics across different generations, single & double battle analysis, competitive Pokémon, common movesets & items
- SCORING:**
 - All questions will have been assigned a predetermined number of points that will be indicated on the test.
 - The highest score wins.
 - Selected questions will be used to break ties
