

# POKÉMON B/C

1. **DESCRIPTION:** Participants will demonstrate an understanding of the Pokémon franchise. (For any clarifications/questions, competitors should reach out to [jpan346@gatech.edu](mailto:jpan346@gatech.edu).)  
**A TEAM OF UP TO:** 2  
**APPROXIMATE TIME:** 50 minutes  
**CALCULATOR:** Class II
2. **EVENT PARAMETERS:**
  - a. Each team must bring writing utensils.
  - b. Each team may bring up to two class I or class II calculators.
  - c. No resources **or other tools**, except those provided by the Event Supervisor, may be used.
3. **THE COMPETITION:**
  - a. The event will test competitors' knowledge and understanding on the following topics:
    - i. **Pokémon identification:** Identify based on appearance, identify its type(s), abilities, evolutions, etc.
    - ii. **Official Pokémon Games:**
      1. Mainline series: Release dates, storyline, locations, prominent NPCs (gym leaders, evil team admins, etc.)
      2. Spin-offs: Storyline, gameplay,
    - iii. **Pokemon puzzles:** puzzles found in the games (strength puzzles, ice puzzles), puzzles themed around Pokémon (Pokédoku, Pokédle, etc.)
    - iv. **Pokémon TCG:** TCG Expansion Sets, popular chase cards, card effects (foil, holographic), game knowledge, etc.
    - v. **Pokémon Battles:** Battle mechanics across different generations, single & double battle analysis, competitive Pokémon, common movesets & items
4. **SCORING:**
  - a. All questions will have been assigned a predetermined number of points that will be indicated on the test.
  - b. The highest score wins.
  - c. Selected questions will be used to break ties
